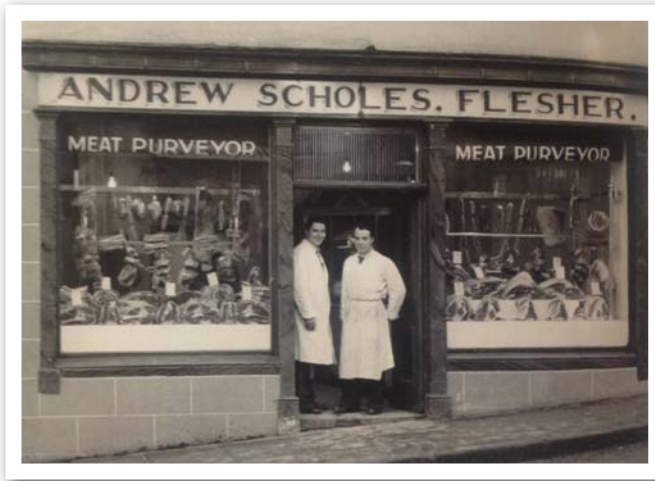


The money we use today began being used in **1971**. Before that people used **Pounds**, **Shillings** and **Pence**.
