

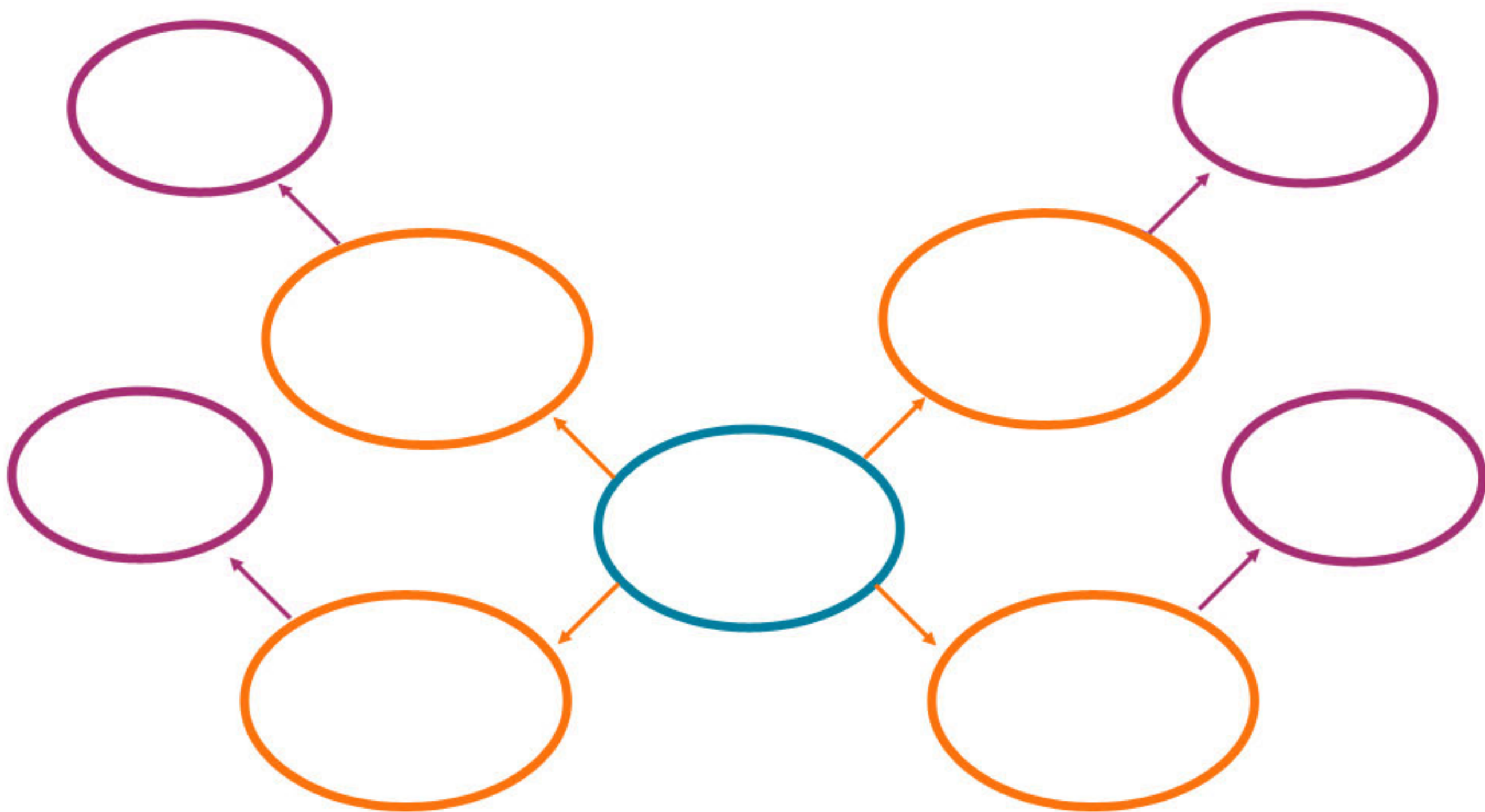
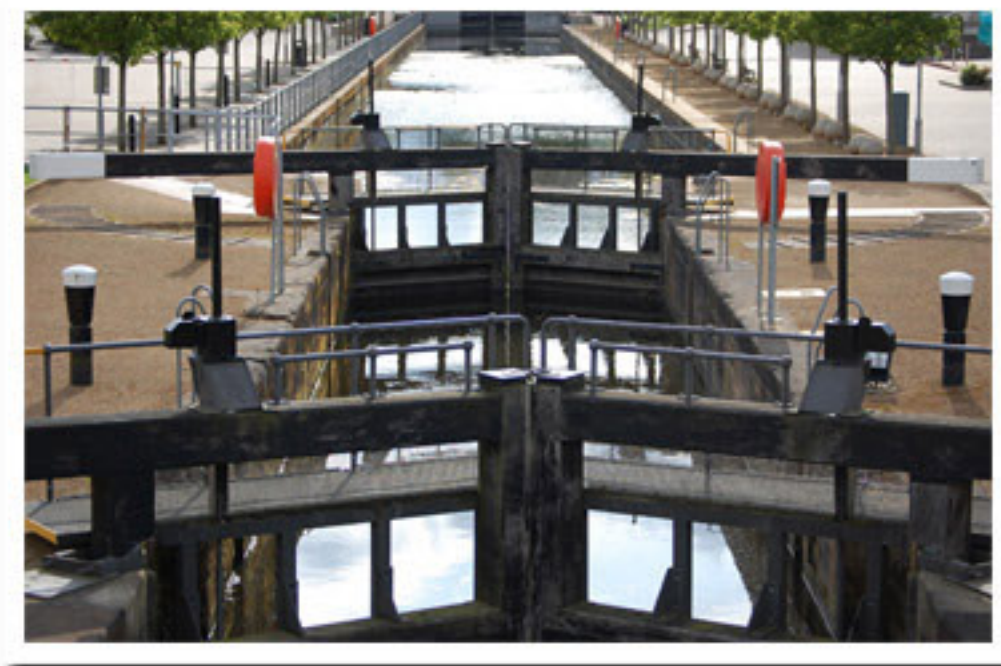
The building of the canal
