

How do minibeasts use colour to protect themselves?

Some minibeasts use colour to match the colour of their bodies to their habitat or home. This is called **camouflage**.

Some minibeasts make their bodies stand out with bright colours so that predators know they taste horrible. These are called **warning colours**.
