

# Activity: Camouflage game

## Learning objectives

To illustrate how camouflage works.

## Teacher Preparation

- Cut lengths of wool of varying colours: 5 red, 5 green, 5 brown and 5 blue.
- Hide them in a confined area

## Main activity

1. Explain that the wool has been hidden and that they have only two minutes to find as many of the 20 pieces as they can, without touching or removing them.
2. Ask them to keep a tally of their findings.
3. Allow them to complete the graph back in the classroom.
4. Answer questions and discuss answers.
