




THE BEST WAY TO WATCH WILDLIFE IS FROM A HIDE. NATURE RESERVES AND BIRD SANCTUARIES OFTEN HAVE LARGE WOODEN PERMANENT HIDES. IT IS VERY EASY TO MAKE YOURSELF A PORTABLE HIDE.

WHAT YOU NEED

- An old blanket (dark colour if possible)
- 2 strong, lightweight poles
- Nails
- Strong string or rope
- 4 tent pegs
- 1 large button
- 1. Nail the blanket to the two poles.
- 2. The poles should have sharp ends so that they can be pushed easily into soft ground.
- 3. To increase stability attach 2 guy ropes to the top of each pole and peg out on either side of the hide with tent pegs.
- 4. Cut a viewing slit at a comfortable height for looking through. It can be held open by a piece of string tied to a large button sewn on the top of the slit, on the views side of the hide.
- 5. This type of hide must be placed so that you have thick vegetation at your back.
- 6. Keep still and quiet and you may be lucky enough to observe some of the shyer wildlife.
