Activity: Seed necklace



Learning objectives

- Create and follow a pattern.
- Create a necklace.






Equipment & Resources

- Seeds
- Paint
- Darning needle
- Thread

Prior Preparation

- Paint seeds and allow them to dry.
- Pierce a hole in each seed.
- Pre-cut a length of thread for each child, long enough to go over their head with 3-4 inches to spare.



Main activity

- 1. When seeds are dry and pierced, thread them.
- 2. When the thread is about two thirds filled, knot the ends together tightly.

Tip

- This can be done with any type of seed.
- For a variation, have children knot threads between threading seeds.
- This can also be used to make a bracelet.
