And birds away.

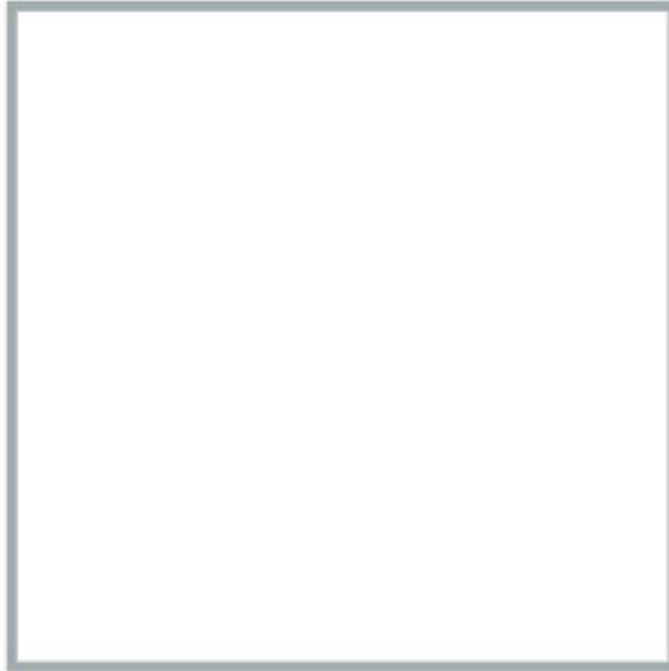
And slowly
