

Can you match the parts of a river with the descriptions below?

Meander	The place where a river flows to. This could be a larger river, a lake or even the sea.
Source	This is the bottom of a river. It is often made of stones, sand or soil.
River bed	This is a bend in a river, usually in the middle course.
River bank	A small stream or river that runs into a bigger river.
Mouth	This is the start of the river. It is usually found in the hills or mountains.
Tributary	This is the ground at the side of a river.
