# Activity: Tree Trail



## Learning objectives

- To observe and identify different tree species in the field.
- To encourage pupils to explore different shapes, colours and
- textures found in the natural world.
- To investigate different habitats.
- To look at different leaves, seeds, buds and berries.





#### Teacher preparation

Site visit, risk assessment, plan a route and photocopy/ laminate ID charts. This activity can be accompanied by several other activities (see below).

### Equipment & Resources

- Identification charts
- Bags for collecting leaves etc.
- Maps of Lagan Valley Regional Park

## Main activity:

- 1. Tell each child to sit around a tree. Ask them to look at it closely.
- 2. Explain that they need to look at the shapes, textures and colours. Have them draw a quick sketch.
- 3. Now tell them to narrow their eyes and look closely at the tree. Can they see any unusual shapes?
- 4. If so, what? (E.g. people can often see faces in the bark)
- Now have them sketch some of the things they can make out in the tree.

This exercise can also be done by looking closely at the clouds.
