
How old is your tree?





- 1. In pairs, select a tree you would like to find out more about.
- 2. Have a look at your tree. How old do you think it is?

 Using a measuring tape measure right around the tree at about your chest height. This is the circumference or the girth.

Circumference =

- 4. A trees circumference grows on average 2cm a year. Therefore to work out how old your tree is simply divide its circumference (girth) by 2.
- 5. What is the circumference of your tree?
